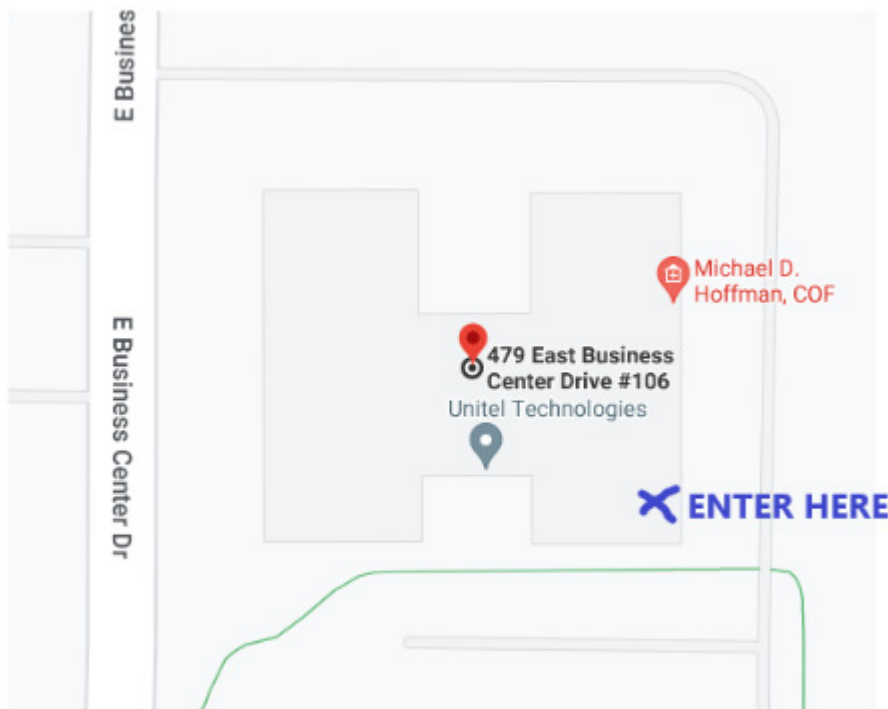

PRESENTED BY DAVID MACPHERSON**

**David MacPherson, designer and owner of Studio Electric Loudspeakers
(<https://www.studio-electric.com/index.html>) will be demonstrating their model M4
and model M5**

**speakers. David has a 30 year history of designing speakers for professional and home
use. Both stand-mount speakers have been demoed at AXPOA in recent years to great
effect, especially in regards to bass and musicality. The speakers feature gel-coated
paper and copolymer drivers as well as soft dome tweeters
contributing to their sound.**

To quote from their website:

All of our exceptional loudspeakers share these common traits:

*Voicing: Our speakers are FUN to listen to. We use modern computer aided
measurement tools to insure accurate reproduction, but the final decision on
speaker voicing is always based on subjective listening with a core question: "Are
we feeling an emotional connection to the music, or are we just listening to audio
equipment?"*

*Value: Studio Electric loudspeakers are often included in audio show reports on
"favorite systems" lists. We consistently receive calls and emails from happy

**SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 21 MEETING-JANSZEN 9.5 LOUDSPEAKERS
PRESENTED BY DAVID JANSZEN**

We are very happy to welcome back David Janszen, founder and designer of Janszen Audio (<https://janszenaudio.com/>) who will be demonstrating his flagship 9.5 loudspeaker. David Janszen carries on the legacy of his father Arthur Janszen, inventor of the first practical electrostatic transducer in the early 1950's.

The 9.5 Loudspeaker is modeled after Arthur A. Janszen's famed KLH Nine, but modernized with a freshened look and vastly improved performance and practicality. The bass section

consists of a 6-driver ceramic passive array crossed over at 200HZ. The electrostatic section consists of 5 narrow vertical sequential time delay strips that enable far wider horizontal dispersion than a flat electrostatic element combined with the advantages of the uniform wave-launch of a vertical line source.
